

CITY OF NEW BRIGHTON ELECTION SIGNS

Sec. 9-040. (3) H. Regulations:

Non-commercial signs of any size may be posted in any number in even numbered years from 46 days before the state primary election until ten days following the state general election and in odd numbered years from the last day of candidate filing until ten days following the city election. All such signs shall be subject to the following requirements:

1. Signs are permitted on private property only and may be placed only upon approval of the property owner.
2. No such sign may be located closer than seven feet to the paved portion of a street.
3. The property owner on which campaign signs are located shall be responsible for the removal of such signs within ten days following the election.
