



Information about Snow Plowing from your Public Works Department

As defined in the City Code, the Public Works Department will plow sidewalks and trails using two trackless snowplows with blowers.

Sidewalks and trails are plowed as thoroughly as possible but not necessarily to bare pavement. The City does not use chemicals for ice control on sidewalks and trails.

Plowing of the sidewalks system begins at the same time the plowing of streets begins. The goal is to have sidewalks in school areas cleared before the opening of school, but not before the adjacent streets are cleared. The streets in front of schools are priority routes and are plowed first.

Park paths and walkways are plowed after sidewalks are cleared.

The public is asked to assist the City:

- Keep garage cans and recycling bins out of the way for plowing.
- Do not park vehicles on streets to allow for complete plowing.
- Keep children's forts away from curbs for safety.
- Clean snow from fire hydrants for access when needed.
- Stay away from snow plows, especially behind them, as they back up frequently.
- Do NOT blow snow in the street. This is against the law.
