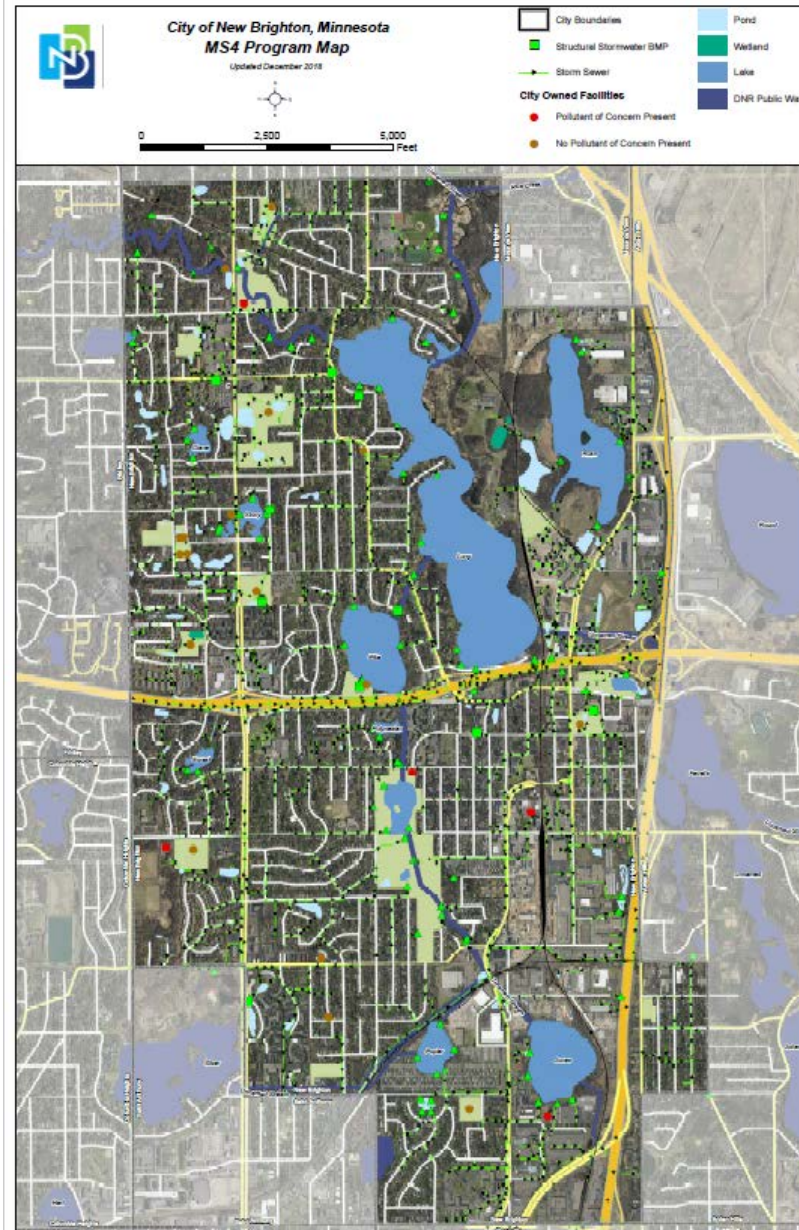

Minimum Control Measure 3
Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination

- Documentation and response to an illicit discharge
- Public Works, Police, and Fire staff training

- Site plan reviews – 6
- Active MPCA construction permittees in the City - 6
- Construction site inspections - 28

Minimum Control Measure 6
Pollution Prevention and Good Housekeeping

- Public works inspections and maintenance
- Salt application monitoring
- Structural stormwater BMP inspections – 36
- BMP cleaning and repairs
